






As an international student in Canada, you're in a new country and likely learning to do a lot of new things on your own. During this important stage of life, you want to be as smart as you can be about your money.

Here are some tips we'd suggest to help you make smart choices.

Tip #1: Make a budget to understand how much you can spend and save.

Knowing your fixed monthly expenses is one of the first steps that help you understand how much you can spend and how much you can save. Get to know the cost of things that may be new to you in Canada, like transportation, groceries, local entertainment, cell phone plans, etc. Once you know what your expenses may now cost you in Canada, you can try to set some extra money aside each month to save for a future need.

Tip # 2: Apply for a credit card as soon as you arrive.

Building a good credit history is important if you want to build a solid financial future in Canada. It can help you get approved for things like cell phones, apartment rentals, loans, lines of credit and even a mortgage. But building a good credit history can take time, so the sooner you apply for a credit card, the sooner you'll start building your credit history. Remember to always pay at least your minimum payment for that credit card on time to maintain a good credit history.

Tip #3: Set up automatic bill payments so you never miss a bill payment.

Getting behind on monthly bills or other expenses can make it challenging to catch up and may impact your credit score. Use tools like Scotiabank's Pre-Authorized Payments to help you pay bills including your credit cards minimum payments automatically and on time without worry.
